BEAM is a comprehensive, early-intervention treatment program for mood disorders with psychotic features. Developed based on the (re)MIND® model, BEAM uses evidence-based practices to support individuals and their families.

To be eligible for the BEAM program, participants must:

- Be an Alameda County resident
- Have experienced severe mood disorder within the past two years
- Be 15-24 years old
- Have Alameda County Medi-Cal or be Medi-Cal-eligible

BEAM is a program of Felton Institute.

BEAM is committed to transforming the treatment and perception of severe mood disorders in their early stages. BEAM provides evidence-based and culturally responsive assessment, diagnosis and treatment interventions. With BEAM young people can learn skills to manage the ups and downs of severe mood changes.
